





- ✓ improve the productivity by providing the aids to needy persons










Damage reduction against large-scale typhoon ~ Philippines

Launched research and development of the "Coastal Disaster Simulation System" to examine and assess disaster reduction effects by Green infrastructure

Granted by the Environment Research and Technology Development Fund in March 2017.

Develop the disaster reduction and life cycle cost assessment method by the optimum combination of the green (mangrove) and the gray (embankment) against typhoons, high tides, and high waves.


Prevent crimes and accidents by recognition technologies

Improve surveillance efficiency by detecting unusual human and traffic related behaviors in specific scenarios:

ex. Railways station, Banking areas, Access roads, streets, parks & open places.









Effective waste collection by using "IoT" \sim Santander, Spain

Joint venture with Spanish waste collection service provider ASCAN

Real time data collection about the quantity of the waste and the location of bin



Analyze the data at the management center, show appropriate collection route and timing to the waste collection vehicle.





 Implemented a sophisticated waste collection service for the city of Santander in Spain using sensors and Big Data analytics This reduced unnecessary collection trips, thereby reducing operating costs and CO₂ emissions.



Optimize Logistics ~India




Delhi-Mumbai Industrial Corridor Project

- Container tracking service utilizing Logistics Visualization System
- Real time recognition of accurate location of transporting containers
- Contribution to decrease the transportation lead-time, cost and to improve the accuracy of manufacturing
- Contribute to consumption reduction of the fossil fuel

 Modal shift will be accelerated by the improvement of railroad, and a large CO2 reduction is expected






